



## **PROPOSALS SOLICITED TO TEACH BOUNDARIES & ETHICS WORKSHOPS FOR NASW-WI IN 2026 AND 2027**

The National Association of Social Workers, Wisconsin Chapter (NASW-WI) is seeking proposals to present Boundaries & Ethics workshops in 2026 and 2027.

NASW-WI's Continuing Education Committee is particularly interested in ethics and boundaries workshops covering the following topics:

- 1) Internal ethics and boundary concerns in the workplace,
- 2) Ethics and Boundaries in this current political climate
- 3) Self-care, self-growth and social work ethics and boundaries
- 4) Ethics and boundaries working in inter-disciplinary practice settings
- 5) Ethics and boundaries concerns for the supervisor and supervisee during clinical and non-clinical supervision

All ethics and boundaries workshops should include discussions of experiences that reflect the diversity of social workers and the populations we serve.

In addition, NASW-WI's Continuing Education Committee will consider other foci and approaches that could meet the needs of an advanced or specialized practitioner. This workshop should also include the discussion of at least one ethical decision-making model and case discussions. All workshops will be expected to include aspects of the NASW Code of Ethics and MPSW 20. Social work boundaries should be integrated into the workshop. The proposal should thoroughly describe the approach to this workshop, including a workshop outline. Student or workshop evaluations of previous ethical workshops taught by the instructor can be submitted as part of the application.

NASW-WI will pay presenters \$700 for the first program presented for NASW-WI and \$800 for subsequent presentations. In addition to the paid presentations, accepted presenters may be asked to present their workshop at an NASW-WI annual conference in exchange for free conference attendance.
